

GMO/IRRADIATION/SEWER SLUDGE DECLARATION

The source materials used in the production process of pectin are **not** derived from genetically modified organisms. In the manufacturing of pectin there are no processing aids (such as enzymes) which are derived from genetically modified organisms. Isopropanol is the only aid used in the extraction of pectin.

In order to standardize the functionality of the product as sold, sucrose, dextrose and buffer salts may be added. Although enzymes may be used in the production process of these raw materials, we have been assured that they do **not** contain genetically modified organisms.

Furthermore, all of our pectin and related raw materials are **not** manufactured using irradiation or sewer sludge during processing.
